

Hispanic/Latina(o) Leadership Programs

For over 20 years, the Hispanic/Latino(a) Leadership Programs (HLPs) at Princeton Theological Seminary have sought to be a space of mutual learning, training, spiritual strengthening, and fellowship for the growing “Comunidad Latina” in the USA.

In developing programs in Spanish, Portuguese and English, the goals of the HLPs are to continually develop lay and clergy leaders, and congregations, with social and theological integrity coming from a Latin American Christian perspective.

Programs

- ***Congreguémonos***
Is a one-day gathering of Latino(a)/Latin American laity and clergy for worship, training and fellowship
- ***Academia de Estudios Bíblicos y Teológicos***
The purpose of the Academy of Biblical and Theological Studies is to provide a consistent tooling experience for lay leaders for a relevant Christian pastoral/missional action and interpretation. The *Academia* offers a Certificate in General Biblical and Theological Studies, and is planning to offer advanced certificates in Multicultural Ministry, Christian Education, and Pastoral Care, among others.
- ***Latino/a Leadership Institute***
A two-day program offered annually for individuals engaged in pastoral leadership, or others active in specialized ministries. Individuals can receive continuing education units (CEUs) through the institute.
- ***Latina/o Officers Training***
Offered annually at the beginning of the year, this event gathers Latino/a lay leaders elected to offices of diverse Christian traditions. Besides offering the training required by denominations, this one-day event seeks to be a space of ecumenical fellowship and spiritual strengthening.
- ***Herencia Lecture***
The Herencia Lecture is an academic, theological, and ecclesiological venue to discuss issues pertaining the Latina/o community, its theological thought, and its relevance in and contribution to the greater Church. This event is planned in collaboration with the Latin@ Collegium at Princeton Seminary
